There will also be opportunities for our Pioneer veterans to visit classrooms at both of our campus buildings after the event.

Dress Down Day - Friday, September 20

Dress Down Day is the 3rd Friday of each month. While being in school uniform is optional on this day, school-appropriate clothing must still be worn. Pajama bottoms and jeans that are ripped to the point that undergarments can be seen are not allowed. "Short" shorts are not allowed. Leggings are allowed as long as they do not have holes. The requirement for shoes is the same for regular school-uniform days. Shirts must not advertise products that would not be allowed in school, nor may they contain language that is unacceptable in our school environment. The final decision about what is appropriate rests with school administration. While we certainly don't like to do so, we will contact you to return to campus if students are not wearing approved clothing.

Finally, I would like to remind our PSPA community that we are fortunate to have amazing parents and staff who go above and beyond when it comes to providing our Pioneer students with fun activities beyond the school day. Without staff who give time away from their families and volunteers who do the same, special events that are held throughout the year would not be possible. Please remind your students that the expectations for student behavior and being respectful of others and our property are the same at out-of-school events as they are during the school day. Before dropping your student off at a school event, be it an athletic function, a field trip, dance, etc., please be sure to speak to them about the importance of upholding our Pioneer values.
