iReady Work

As we have now completed iReady Assessments for the fall, students should have their individualized path ready for them to work on. Most students will be able to complete this work during Pioneer Time, but some may need to complete at home.

Teachers and staff will be analyzing the data to make decisions about instructional practices, as well as determining if students are misplaced on their individualized plan based on their ability level. We do have some students who may not have taken the assessment as seriously as we hoped.
