TECHNOLOGY-ALL STUDENTS

We want to update you on technology usage and a new policy we are implementing:

Sixth Graders will begin having after school access to their computers starting tomorrow, September 9. Students are still responsible for bringing their laptops home to charge on a daily basis.

All students will have access to their computers shut down at 10:00 pm each night and then reactivated again at 7:00 am each morning, including weekends and holidays. This will begin tomorrow, September 9. Our students need to get good sleep and not having computer access will help with that. Be sure to work with your child on time management so they complete whatever they need to outside of that time.

IREADY UPDATE

I know that many of our students are excited about iReady and are ready to get started, but we are having difficulty getting that together. Ms. Johnson (and Ms. Yencha at the elementary school) is working hard to get it up and running, but we are waiting on others to do what needs to be done on their end. We will keep you updated on the status.
