Greetings PSPA Families,

As we head off for the Thanksgiving holiday, here are a few items I wish to share.

#### Open Enrollment for 2025-26 School Year

Please read this carefully. Our annual open enrollment for the next school year will begin on December 3.

- 1. Current Pioneer students <u>do not</u> need to submit a new enrollment form. This open enrollment is only for new prospective students. An Intent to Return form will be sent out in mid-February for existing PSPA students.
- 2. While current PSPA students should not apply through this application process, *an enrollment application must be submitted for prospective siblings* of current students.
- 3. This open enrollment is only for students who wish to enroll in our traditional K-8 school, or for our Blended Academy (5-10) option. Enrollment for our full-time virtual school, Pine Springs Virtual Academy, will not begin until late winter of 2025.
- 4. If you are seeking to enroll a sibling of a current PSPA student, you must submit their enrollment application during the enrollment period of 12/3/24 2/3/25. Any enrollment applications received after 2/3/25 will not be eligible for the lottery and the student will be placed at the end of the queue after all lottery placements have been determined.
- 5. While siblings of current PSPA students are given preference for open seats for the following school year, it is important to note that "preference" does not mean it is a guarantee; and, if you don't submit an enrollment application for the sibling before 2/3/25, no preference will be given.
- 6. If your current Pioneer is in our Blended Academy and is seeking to switch to the traditional option, or if your current Pioneer is in our traditional option and would potentially like to switch to the Blended Academy, please contact Principal Alharoon to discuss your student's situation (malharoon@pinespringsprep.org).
- 7. The enrollment lottery will be held on February 24, 2025. You must have your prospective student's application completed and submitted by 2/23/24 in order for it to be included in the lottery.

Again, current students who are seeking to remain at PSPA should not submit a new enrollment application.

Feel free to share this information with family and friends who may be seeking to enroll their student with PSPA for the 2025-26 school year.

What is supposed to happen is that if you purchase an item, it will then be automatically removed from that student's registry. Once purchased, the gift will be mailed to an address that the family provided to their school.

If you do purchase a gift for a student, please put a check in column F of the spreadsheet so that others will know that at least one gift has been purchased for that student. You are welcome to purchase another gift for a student even if someone else has put a check in column F. Our goal is to have at least one gift purchased from each student's registry.

Thank you for your consideration. I know it will mean a lot to the students and their families to be on the receiving end and to know that those outside of their community are still very much thinking of them during this challenging time.
