Afternoon Carline at K-5 Building – Do not arrive prior to 2:15pm

K-5 parents who are arriving in the afternoon for carline pickup should not arrive before 2:15pm. may as dismissal does not begin until 2:45pm for car riders. The volume of cars arriving earlier than 2:15pm has steadily increased, which creates a safety concern should we need to have emergency personnel or others get the school prior to dismissal.


